

WAH KWONG CELEBRATES 60 YEARS IN STYLE

HONG KONG'S Wah Kwong Shipping pushed the boat and the book out when they invited the territory's maritime elite to help them celebrate 60 years on the world's oceans. The event was matched by the location – the new, yet to be opened Hong Kong Maritime Museum, a spectacular new venue at the Star Ferry Pier in the Central Business District that will officially open its doors to the public in February 2013.
